Frank Paulhamus Scholarship

The Lake Soil and Water Conservation District will award a scholarship for the sum of \$500.

The scholarship is presented to a high school senior residing in Lake County and will have two ways to be considered for the scholarship:

- Community College, University, or Trade School Major in an agricultural field such as: agricultural education, agricultural economics, agricultural engineering, agronomy, forestry, horticulture, soils, or wildlife management.
- Career Start a business in an agricultural field.

The recipient must demonstrate ability, knowledge, and need in the application. If the recipient changes his or her career field, the check will be given to the 2nd place applicant if he or she is still in compliance with the guidelines.

Those interested in applying for this scholarship must fill out an application, which can be found on the website at www.lakecountyfl.gov/lswcd, or call the office at 352-253-1646 to receive a copy.

The application deadline **April 1, 2019**, and must be received in the Educational Foundation Office at 2045 Pruitt Street, Leesburg, FL 34748 by **3:00 p.m.**
