Would you consider this a multi-year project? The project we are working on will definitely be multi year. The idea will span the next several years and help to train more students to work on the much larger projects like Stepping out for Education.

Project Abstract -- The project that I am proposing is to allow younger students in my TV Production program to work on the larger projects that only a few upper level students edit. Every year we run into a roadblock when only one or two students have worked on larger projects. This is because they take up so much space on the computer that most of my machines can not even open them. I want to purchase several more hard drive bays and several more drives so that we can clone projects and drives to train the younger students. By cloning them, there is no worry that they will mess up the original. This eliminates the worry in the production process and trains the next generation of editors to work with extreme amounts of footage.

Project Detail

The goals and objectives for this projects are to increase the number of students working on larger projects and advanced editing. We are looking to take our first round of certification tests in November. The students would still have 2 more tries to certify in the spring. By working more with Adobe Premiere on the larger projects, student will gain more exposure to the various tools that are on the test. Just doing basic editing last year was not sufficient enough to pass many students.

We offer certification in Adobe Premiere and hopefully Adobe After Effects coming soon. We also offer Final Cut Pro certification to the few that make it into the other editing program.

My target number for certifications this year is 30. Last year we only had 3 certify, so we want to jump it up to at least 30 this year.
