**Timeline:**

Students will:

3. Will present to other students their paper and thesis via a power point slide show within nine to ten weeks of starting their course.
4. Students will assess each other's projects utilizing a teacher provided rubric within nine to ten weeks of starting their course.
5. Students will take their Multi-Media Exam as soon as they are prepared to do so. The students will be working at their own pace, so they will take the exam when they are ready. Essentially the students will take the Multi-Media Exam for certification purposes sometime during the last eight weeks of class.

Multi-Media Certification Exam Dates: To be taken during the last eight weeks of the course (Depending on their performance in the course).

**Outcome Measures**

At the beginning of the course, the students will prepare and present a power point presentation. At the completion of the course, the students will be given the above assignment (Project Details) to complete. Afterwards the students will be evaluated on the progress made as far as quality (facts, research, writing ability, presentation ability, citing ability, and MLA formatting) per a teacher made rubric to determine progress made.
