Project Abstract:

Our Television Production academy is seeking this generous grant to help enable 20 of or upper division students (Television 3 & 4) to attend and participate in the 2019 Florida Scholastic Press Association (FSPA) State Convention in April 2019. This annual convention is an excellent opportunity for our high achieving television production students to learn additional valuable industry skills, to network with industry professionals and other similar television students, and to contest their individual productions up against their peers. Attending this convention will better prepare our students to successfully work in an array of television industry jobs after graduation, as well as give them tremendous professional networking experience. We hope a grant of \$2250 can help offset the expenses for each student's convention attendance fees and costs, and their required chaperones.

Additionally, our program is in great need for new sturdy and functionable camera monopods for their many classroom assignments and individual projects, and to upgrade our lavalier microphones supply. Learning to shoot steady, yet quickly portable video is a key industry skill I hope all my students will develop. Five new monopods at approximately \$25 per unit would be a huge addition to our equipment arsenal for this school year and future television production classes. We also request funding for four new Sony-44B omnidirectional microphones for our field television production assignments at approximately \$156 per unit.
