Program Rationale: (Why is this program important?)

As you may know, Groveland Elementary is a Title 1 school with over 80% of its population identified as economically disadvantaged. Even though we are in the "Sunshine State" many of our students have never traveled to the coast, or even outside of our county, much less to Kennedy Space Center. Many students do not realize that it is even located in our state. Most of our students have never had the opportunity to experience the Kennedy Space Center due to cost restraints for both parents and children to attend.

Program Impact: (How will the teachers and students benefit from this project?)

Our 5th grade students need experiences that will give them background knowledge needed to understand many of the science standards in 5th grade and throughout their educational career. Our students need this field trip and experience to better grasp concepts in force and motion, chemical energy, Earth/Space science, and engineering. Our students need to learn about jobs that are accessible, not only for engineers, but also for other trades.


Program Evaluation Method: (How will you measure teacher and student success?)


