Program Rationale: (Why is this program important?)

Bullying has become an epidemic in today's schools. We want to use this WONDERful book to inspire students to be kind to one another. We believe this book will teach students important lessons of kindness, perseverance and friendship, all while teaching ELA standards. While reading, students will have meaningful discussions, write to respond to text, share their opinions and learn academic grade level vocabulary and standards.

Program Impact: (How will the teachers and students benefit from this project?)

Students will learn important life lessons, such as, it is better to be kind than to be right and all people should be treated respectfully and nicely no matter their appearance. Students will also master the ELA standards: Determine main idea and explain how it is supported by key details. RI.1.2; Determine a theme of a story, drama or poem from details in the text. RL.1.2; Compare and contrast the point of view from which different stories are narrated and will be able to tell the difference between first and third-person narrations. RL.2.6; Explain how an author uses reasons, and evidence to support particular points in a text. RI.3.8; Describe a character, setting, or event using specific details from the text. RL.1.3; Explain events and concepts in historical and scientific text using specific information in the text. RI.1.3; Compare and contrast the point of view from which different stories are narrated, including the difference between first-and- third-person narrations. RL.2.6; Distinguish between firsthand and secondhand accounts and understand the difference between them. RI.2.6.

Program Evaluation Method: (How will you measure teacher and student success?)

Students will have a formal assessment on the book's comprehension and on the ELA standards. Students will also keep a reader's notebook throughout the novel study that will be graded based on a rubric. The reader's notebook will include discussion journals, opinion and informative writing, vocabulary activities and an analysis of the text.
