<b>Project Detail</b>		
<b>Other Funding Sources:</b> Seven computers have been donated to my classroom through the Farmer's Thank America's Teachers/Adopt a Classrooms grant. Four computers are HP Streams and three computers are Chromebooks.		
<b>Program Rationale:</b> (Why is this program important?) Our school system is going one to one Chromebooks for grades 3-12 over the next several years. Elementary schools will be the last to receive these Chromebooks. I teach 2 <sup>nd</sup> grade and will not have one to one Chromebooks. I have been given seven computers, through other grant sources, for my classroom. Unfortunately, these computers are not on the county network. This project would purchase the management software and would allow the computers to run on the Lake County student network; essentially turning these computers into Chromebooks. I could then utilize these computers to help my 21 <sup>st</sup> Century learners collaborate and learn together through Google Classroom.		
<b>Program Impact:</b> (How will the teachers and students benefit from this project?) Lake County's initiative for using Google Classroom is perfect for our Read, Write, Think, and Speak in all academic subjects. In this platform, even young learners in 2 <sup>nd</sup> grade will be able to collaborate with partners and groups as they learn. Having computers in the classroom makes opportunities for learning available immediately, instead of having to sign up and wait for our half hour block of time in a computer lab. Students will be provided with choices to demonstrate their learning. In using Google Classroom, the possibilities are endless.		
<b>Program Evaluation Method:</b> (How will you measure teacher and student success?) Student success can be measured in the variety of ways the students demonstrate mastery of standards, whether they use Google Classroom to upload a video they have created, design a slide presentation, use Google Drawings to create a comic book or poster, or create and answer discussion questions in a blog post. When students are provided multiple opportunities to have a voice and a choice in their assignments, they are more likely to remain fully engaged. Students who struggle with "traditional" classwork can shine when given choices. This creates success both in academic growth in grades and assessments, as well as in self-confidence. Oh the places they can go!		
<b>Program Timeline:</b> (provide a project start date and completion date) This project would begin as soon as funds were available and a work order is sent in for Lake County's IT Department to install the software. The intent would be to begin on or near October 1, 2018. The project would last as long as the computers last, up to five years or until the 2023-2024 school year, which by that time, each kindergarten through second grade will receive five Chromebooks for classroom use.
