As we work with our students to encourage collaboration and teamwork, the current desks in room 06-118 are designed for straight lines of students facing the front of the room—not for students working together. As we prepare our students for 21st century skills, collaboration and teamwork are key. This grant will allow us to purchase flexible seating to allow for improved collaboration opportunities.

## **Project Detail**

The current classroom configuration in room 06-118, while looking good at first glance, is not advantageous to working in groups and lacks the ability for small group learning and collaboration. The desks in use are bound to other desks in ways that do not allow for rearranging. Three long rows of ten workstations is visually pleasing, but it is difficult for the teacher to move quickly to different parts of the classroom as students need assistance. This in turn, limits simple classroom strategies such as proximity to control student behavior. More importantly, as we try to bring students into working with groups, the areas are not clearly defined and group work can be disorganized.

By installing desks that offer flexible seating, the teacher will be able to more effectively group students for collaborative learning and increase student engagement. Alternate seating will allow even more flexibility for grouping within the classroom.

## **Outcome Measures**

By implementing the change in desks and some seating, there will be improved student engagement, and reduced misbehavior in the classroom. Both of these outcomes will increase students' ability to learn.
