Program Background:

This is the fourth year for our Theatre program at Minneola Charter School. Each year, we have produced one musical. This year, we will be producing 3 musical productions and competing at the district and state level for International Thespian competitions in December and February. Last year, we added a stage and tech crew to the theatre production aspect. This gave students who enjoy theatre a platform for designing and building sets.

Project Summary:

This year students will participate in designing and building a set that will be universal for all three performances. It must be easily movable, durable, weight bearing, and usable for several shows.

Need:

Our students need wood, screws, casters, paint, and tools to build the sets.
