**Program Rationale:** (Why is this program important?) Additional funds will allow our teachers an opportunity to grow their classroom libraries. Guthrie and Humenick, authors and reading specialists, found that when kids have access to a wide range of interesting text, text selected by them, their motivation for reading increased, as did their reading comprehension (2004). Their research states when kids do not have access to books in their lives outside of school, they need even more opportunities to read in school every day, to include reading books of choice. Choice cannot happen without our teachers offering their students a full range of genres and formats. Access and choice are essential components for kids to develop as thriving readers. **Program Impact:** (How will the teachers and students benefit from this project?) This project will provide our teachers with the necessary funds to purchase a variety of texts to grow their classroom libraries. If we flood our classrooms with a variety of books, we have a better chance at reaching ALL of our students. When students read on topics of interest to them, they are more likely to further their understanding, grow their vocabulary and increase their comprehension. With overwhelming evidence, the book Striving to Thriving states that engagement in high-success reading advances student's confidence and competence as readers, better equipping them for life. **Program Evaluation Method:** (How will you measure teacher and student success?) Teachers will ensure the collection of books in their classroom libraries are varied and appealing enough to feed the wide range of readers in their classroom. Teachers and students will see an increase in their i-Ready reading results (kindergarten-second grade) as well as their English Language Arts grades (kindergarten-fifth grade).
