Would you consider this a multi-year project? Our Certified Nursing Students practice all skills required for their training and passing of the exam on manikins. They begin learning all skills on the manikins in the beginning of the year they so when they are able to go to clinical sites and interact with live patients they have learned the skills prior. These manikins are used by every CNA class each year.

Project Abstract: All of our students learn skills that they have never had to perform on another person when they arrive in the CNA program. There are things like bed baths and perineal care (cleaning of the genitalia and rectal regions) that cannot be practiced on classmates for obvious reasons. They are required to know these skills when they arrive in the clinical settings and the manikins make this possible.

Project Detail

The CNA program teaches students all skills necessary to gain employment as a nurses assistant post-secondary. The goal of our program is that all of our students are equipped with the ability to perform these skills safely, efficiently, and in compliance with standards set forth by the Board of Nursing. Students are taught the skills and then are able to practice the skills with the immediate feedback of the instructor to correct or gain their check off on each given skill. The students use the manikins to practice repeatedly so they know the skills completely and will be able to perform them correctly when they are required during their certification process. They must pass a written exam prior to the physical skills portion. The students are observed by two registered nurses from the testing facilitation company, ProMetrix, while they are performing the skills for their final test. Our goal is that all students will pass the test on their first attempt but when this is not the case, the students haves access to the CNA lab to practice and remediate prior to retaking the exam. The certification testing takes place in late April each year prior to the student's graduation.

The students may receive a Certified Medical Administrative Assistant (CMAA) certification as an 11th or 12th grader, or the Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) certification as a 12th grader. These are current certifications offered at our school. What is your target number of students receiving certifications that you are trying to reach? For CMAA there are about 40 students per year. CAN has two classes of 15 students per year as this number is limited by the Board of Nursing. 


