	Other Funding Sources: At this time we have no other funding sources. We have used all possible resources to purchase what chromebooks we can.
	Program Rationale: (Why is this program important?) Grassy Lake Elementary is in need of chromebooks because much of our current technology is out of date and will no longer be usable after January when all computers will be required to run windows 10. The older computers we have are not able to handle the upgrade. In order to meet student needs, we need to obtain replacement computers. Students are required to do iReady and other reading based activities that require usable computers. Also, teachers us these as learning centers to integrate technology in their daily lessons. At one point the county was to roll out new technology to assist with this, but due to budget cuts, this is not going to be happening. We are now pursuing grants and setting up fundraising efforts to overcome this issue.
