Program Rationale: (Why is this program important?)

Younger students need the experience of working with a three-dimensional material like clay. Clay is tactile and every student, regardless of ability or academic proficiency, is able to use clay effectively. Many of these students have had little or no experience working with clay

Program Impact: (How will the teachers and students benefit from this project?)

Students will learn about the scientific process of using clay (ie. Evaporation and chemical change) and will also be able to create a piece of art that is more durable and long-lasting than something created on paper. They will learn about texture and the use of textured objects (like plants or plant products) to create artwork.

Program Evaluation Method: (How will you measure teacher and student success?)

All students, from Pre-K to 5th grade will be able to create at least two hand-built clay projects that can be fired and decorated. Older students will be able to explain the process of using, building, drying and handling clay and should be able to demonstrate it to a classmate or an adult if asked.
