Lake Minneola High School opened its new CNA health lab in the school year of 2017-2018. Currently we are an approved State training cite for the Florida Board of Nursing. Although we have state of the art simulators and some medical equipment, our classroom lack the necessary learning aids for teaching and displaying didactic content. As of now I conduct my classes by projecting presentations from a portable projector onto a wall. Most of the projection is morphed by outlets and window frames limiting my students ability to fully view the visuals. Audio is another big concerns, although I can project an image there is no sound as projectors are not equipped with speakers, and the speakers on the attached laptop sound is not amplified. The project I am proposing is a mounted smart TV with PC streaming. With this equipment I can display on a much larger screen differential relevant content such lab skills and presentations and health related videos that would have a more profound impact on my students learning gains and ultimately receiving their state industry certifications. We currently have a certification pass rate of 84% however, I am confident that we can increase our pass rate to 90% or better. Thank you for your consideration.

April- Nursing Assisting Students sit for state Board and pass CNA Exam with at least 90%. May underclassmen sit for CMAA certification and pass with at least 90% pass rate.




