Program Rationale: (Why is this program important?)

ALL of the students at BSE will benefit from group keyboard lessons during their music classes, and the most interested and promising students will receive private lessons and practice times for the remainder of the school year, allowing them a solid beginner's proficiency. A multitude of studies have results suggesting that students who study instrumental music consistently score higher on standardized *math* tests.

Program Impact: (How will the teachers and students benefit from this project?)t

Students selected for private lesson study generally improve in two basic areas: self concept enhancement and behavior improvement. The acquisition of this lifetime skill is invaluable going forward for these students. Teachers benefit from having their students learn to focus and see results in their ability to concentrate and learn, which is transferred to other classroom subjects and skills.
