Project Need: (Please describe the demographics of your school and why this project is needed)
Hello, and thank you so much for your consideration! Our school auditorium has a very antiquated light system. When I first arrived, it was so bad that it was to a point where the lights would randomly shut off in the middle of our production. While I was able to get that fixed, through the years, the money that I have been able to raise for improvements has all gone to fixing broken equipment because we were unable to afford to replace anything. I would really love to be able to put new LED stage lights in to the auditorium. Not only would it make the lights much more beautiful and easier to use, but it would also allow the students to be trained on equipment that they will more likely see in the real world should they choose to stay in the theatrical industry. Our goal as a county is to have our students college and career ready, and by providing them with equipment that they would be more likely to see in a community or professional theatre, that would really assist with the educational process of lighting design.

Our school is in a very rural area, and we are just above the level to be a title one school. Our county is overall so poor that we received a grant that allows all of our students to have free breakfast and lunch. Because the surrounding area is so poor, I don't charge very much for my shows. I recently just upped the prices to \$5 a ticket, and that's still a struggle to some families. I can't charge any more than that because I would hate for a student to not have an audience because of money, but lower ticket prices mean that it is much harder to raise the money that we need to purchase the new

lighting system.

Our drama program is pretty successful and is very well known through the school, however, these lights wouldn't just help out the drama program. They would also help out the entire school. While drama maintains the auditorium, we all use it. Whether it be for guest speakers, band concerts, awards ceremonies, talent shows, or ultimately our promotion ceremonies, everyone in the entire school gets use out of the auditorium at one time or another. I would love to see a beautiful, professional looking LED light set up so that every student gets to feel like a rock star when we are celebrating whatever success they have achieved.

I have been slowly building the drama budget up each year, but with various fixes here and there, and upping the amount of shows we're paying rights to each year, I fear that it'll be another 10 years before we can afford to get a subpar lighting system. We would greatly appreciate any help you could offer us. Whether that be the money, a portion of the money, or donations of new or used LED lights. It would mean so much to the drama program as well as our school as a whole. Thank you so much for your consideration.

The plan would be to have them come out and hook up our new lighting system. Hopefully they could give me a brief preview on how to use the new system as well so I could then teach my students.

Every person in the entire school will benefit from new lights because everyone uses the auditorium at sometime or another. It would really give our activities, presentations, and performances a more professional look, and allow students to learn how to use lighting equipment they would see in the real world should they decide to work in the theatrical industry.

Project Evaluation Method: (How will you measure teacher and student success?)

We will be able to see a huge difference just by viewing the productions. However, we will also be able to see a difference when attending Junior Thespian competition. Now it is difficult to plan for one act competition because my lighting designers know how to use our antiquated system. When we go to perform our one act at a nearby high school that has the LED lighting system, it is very difficult for them to figure out how to make our lighting cues work on their system in the short amount of time that we are given, so competition scores would be another way to measure student

success. Finally, when I teach lighting design in class, I give the students a chance to learn our lighting board. I don't get a lot of interest in it, and it's very hard to retain students interested in doing the lighting for our shows. I think that with a new and more modern system, I will better be able to teach lighting and keep the students' interest and attention. They really love when they can make the lights change color, but with the old lights, we would have to rent a cherry picker and put a new gel in front of the light. With a new LED system, lights can change with the touch of a button. I would love that kind of freedom with the lighting design for our shows.

I would love to have it finished by our musical this spring, which would be in April 2020. In a perfect world, it would be installed during Spring Break, which is March 16-20. However, if that is too soon, there is a lot of down time in my school over the summer, so that timeline would work out as well.
