We are a Title I School. Most district school based money is spent on instruction and support of our learners. As such there has never been a refresh budget for critical classroom infrastructure. We are using rusted music stands that are 30 years old, some donated music stands from Disney, and several plastic stands left over from when the music suite was renovated in back in the year 2000 which are currently dry rotted and brittle. There is no district budget for music stand refresh/update/repair. It is a rare week that a music stand doesn't give up and break. Each year I am able to spend a little money to refurbish our existing stands, but it's just putting a band aid on a hemorrhage (pun intended). With all fundraising money used to support instrument purchase as well as materials and instruction in the band classroom, very little is left over for the very thing that our students use every single day: music stands. We are in desperate need of a drumline (usable life is 5 years, we're going on year 13 by refurbishing each year), new sousaphones and tubas for a population explosion at the middle schools in band (to the tune of \$7000 new, or \$4500 when I buy them on eBay), as well as having just spent money refurbishing our plastic chairs which were so brittle that each day they were leaving little pink bits on the clothes of our students. We very much need these stands. Its desperate, urgent, and benefits every single student in our band program.

We have a critical need to replace our deteriorated and broken music stands with durable music stands that can be refurbished in the future. Currently our music stands are not able to be refurbished when they break.

Project Detail: (Please provide your project detail)

We would use these music stands every day and at concerts. This is a fundamental piece of a music classroom that is in dire need of replacement. This proposal is for 90 music stands, the appropriate carts to store them, base weights and clips for outdoor events so the stands are not blown over, and locks for enough stands to support heavy music binders. We currently have 120 students in the program, but have enough existing stands to make up the difference.

Within a short amount of time, we will be reading music off the floor or taping it back to the person in front of us.
