**Project Need:** (Please describe the demographics of your school and why this project is needed) Our school is at 54.51% Free or Reduced Lunch eligibility. Our Race/Ethnic breakdown is as follows: 47.89% White/Caucasian, 30.11% Hispanic, 12.99% Black, 3.92% Asian, and 5.09% Other or Multi-racial. We have 21 to 1 Student to Teacher Ratio, and our school is 50.59% Male and 49.41% Female. We are in need of aid to help fund some basic classroom essentials as there is no funding supplied to replace these items as they depreciate and wear. Our school is the last high school built or rebuilt, so the assets in the facilities are aged 27 years, from the time the school opened. Furniture/equipment to perform basic daily functions is necessary to aid in classroom instruction free from distraction of broken equipment or injury due to aging and improper chairs and stands. The chair we currently have were not designed for music instruction classrooms, and are extremely heavy. They also do not stack or transport efficiently and all performance functions of our department put a strain on logistics and safety. The addition of this necessity would bring our department into the 1990's and beyond, as this is something that should already be in place in a minimally outfitted music department. We are in need of new stackable chairs suitable for musician posture. We are also in need of lighter, safer music stands, and storage and transporting solutions.

Our current chairs are not efficiently stackable, and are extremely heavy and difficult to transport, as we have to move chairs on a regular basis. Our current music stands are very heavy as well, and are composed of metal, which has sharp edges, and they are plagued with rust, posing a danger for the students. We also need carts to transport and store our equipment, as we have a daily need to move and store our chairs and stands on carts.
