DREAM SCHOOL

Your test scores, GPA and/or class rank are below those the majority of accepted students. It would take something compelling on your application to override those odds.



MATCH SCHOOL

Your test scores, GPA, and/or class rank are below those of the majority of accepted students or at least fall within a realistic range. You have a reasonable chance (typically better than 50/50) for admission.

SAFETY SCHOOL

Your test scores, GPA, and/or class rank typically fall above the 75th percentile of admitted schools and the school accepts more than 50% of it's applicants. You will almost certainly gain admission.
