Research the employer ahead of time

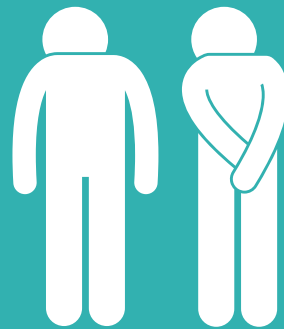
Dress for success

Remember the importance of body language

Your body language says a lot about who you are without you knowing. Make sure to sit up straight, it looks like you have more confidence. Don't cross your arms when meeting someone new.



Ask insightful questions

Don't just ask "how much will I make?" but rather questions like "how did your company handle (insert recent event)." This will allow the employer to know you're serious about the job!



Thank your interviewer
